**Registration Fee.** A Registration Fee of \$100 for each participating band must accompany this form\*\*. If your band ultimately does not participate in the Battle of the Bands, you will receive a full refund; however if you choose to withdraw from the event, you must notify Mr. Williams no later than April 9th or you will forfeit your Registration Fee.

\*\*If a participating band sells 20 or more tickets before the event, the Registration Fee will be refunded. Please make checks payable to **HHEF**.

**Band Participants.** Bands must arrive in the band wing between 3:30 pm and 5:00 pm. Doors will open to the public at 6:00 pm and bands will play at their respective times beginning at 6:30 pm. Once all registration forms are received we will notify you of your time slot. Each band will be given a 30-minute slot to set up their equipment, perform, and clear the stage. **No more than five (5) bands will be permitted to participate and will be included on a first-come, first-served basis.**

**Ticket Sales/HHEF.** Tickets will be sold at the following rates: students will be \$8 each all others will be \$10 each. Seating will be General Admission to the HHHS Theater. Ticket sales will be managed by the Battle of the Bands event sponsor: The Hatboro-Horsham Educational Foundation (HHEF). All proceeds will benefit the HHEF, which is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization whose sole purpose is to provide educational programming and Innovative Learning Grants to the students of the Hatboro-Horsham School District.

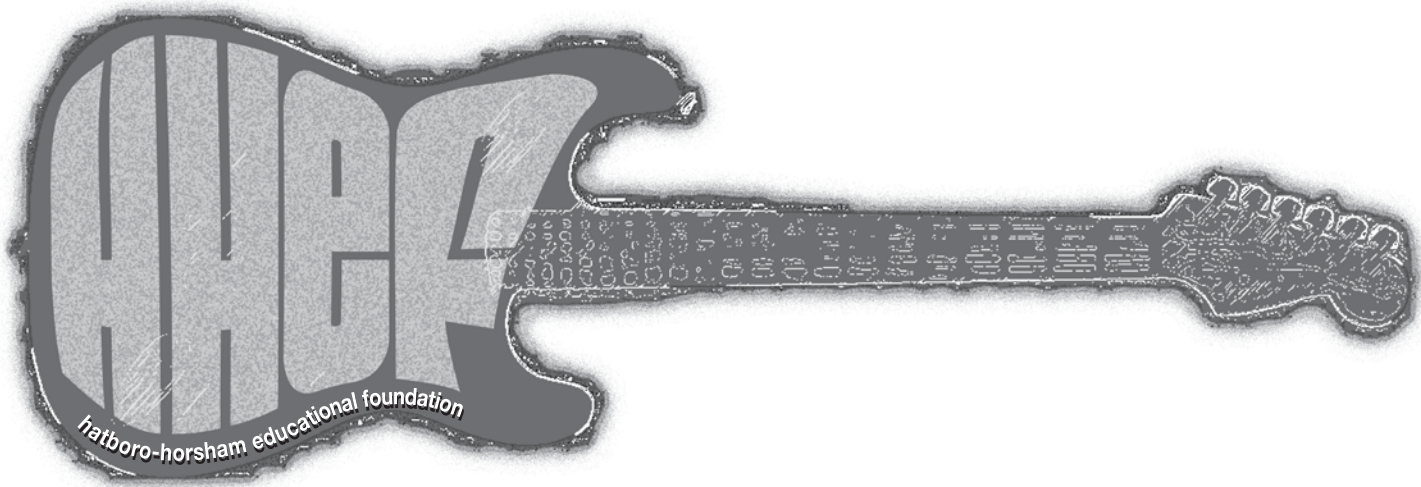
**Judging.** After each performance a panel of judges will rate each band based on 1. Musicality, 2. Originality, 3. Professionalism, 4. Performance, and 5. Crowd Stimulation. A Grand Prize will be presented to the band with the highest cumulative points.

**Band Self-Promotion.** Bands are welcome to sell their own CD's and other promotional items at this event, but they must first be submitted to Mr. Williams for approval. We would appreciate a donation of \$1 from each sale be made to the Hatboro-Horsham Educational Foundation (HHEF).

**The Battle of the Bands is intended to be a family-oriented fund raiser, therefore all participants must submit this form and their lyrics to the HHHS Main Office for approval no later than March 19, 2010, and must not be significantly altered at the event.
